File of Life (FOL) Management with Annual Wellness Visit

Wellness nurses provide an introductory visit with each resident after move-in including File of Life
establishment. An Annual Wellness Visit will include a FOL update and answer any questions you may
have. This service is included with your residency here at OceanView. You are also welcome to call our
office to set up this appointment.

Equipment Loans

We keep a few walkers, commodes and canes on hand to loan. Please call for availability or stop by
during clinic hours if you would like to borrow. Physical or Occupational therapists are providers that
advise people on height specifications of various medical equipment. It is not within a nurse's scope of
practice to make these recommendations. We can loan equipment, but a physician or therapist
provides education on the use of equipment. Borrowed equipment can be dropped back off sanitized.

Case Management Oversight

Balance Screenings

• (Quarterly) FOX Rehab Physical Therapists will evaluate your balance and risk for falls. Sign up at the Activities nook.

Charged Nursing Services

Per hour charges are prorated in 15-minute increments

- Emergency Visits

PRO Services (Preferred Retirement Options)

OceanView's personal care agency includes companions, caregivers, and/or nurses

PRO is managed by our Wellness Coordinator

Per hour charges are charged at the appropriate rate

- **Companions** can assist in everyday tasks such as but not limited to pet care and dog walking, light housekeeping, grocery management, meal preparation, walks, errands, and taking to appointments.
- Caregivers can assist with bathing and all activities of daily living.
- **Nursing** can manage daily and/or weekly medications as well as administer medications. This includes calling in prescriptions, ensuring delivery, filling pill boxes and/or daily medication drops to residents.
